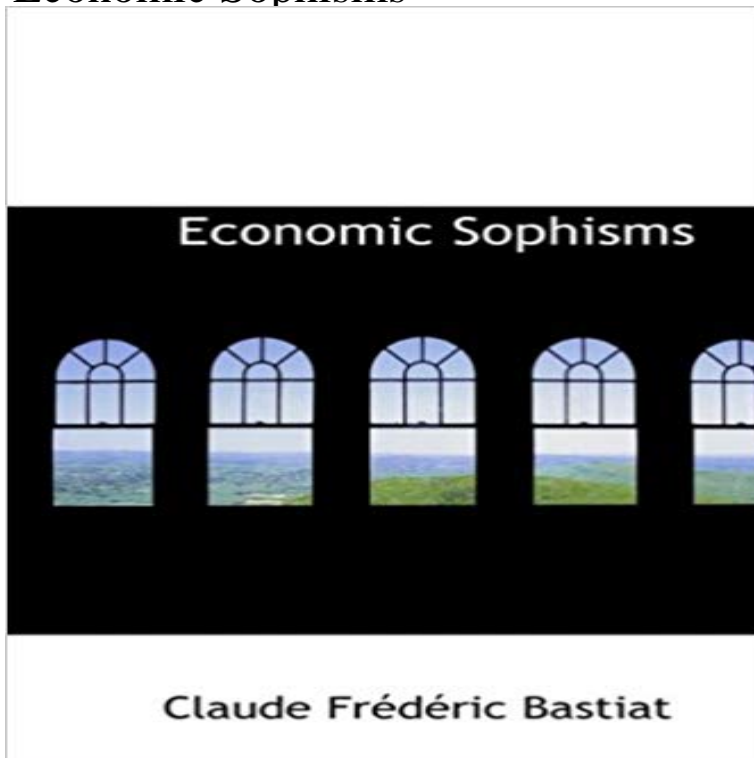


Economic Sophisms
