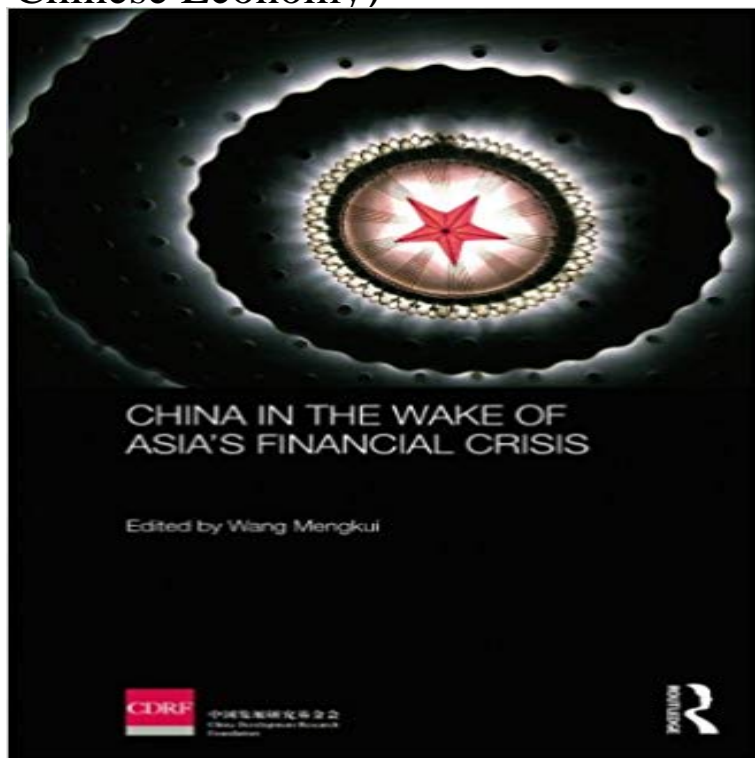


## China in the Wake of Asia's Financial Crisis (Routledge Studies on the Chinese Economy)
