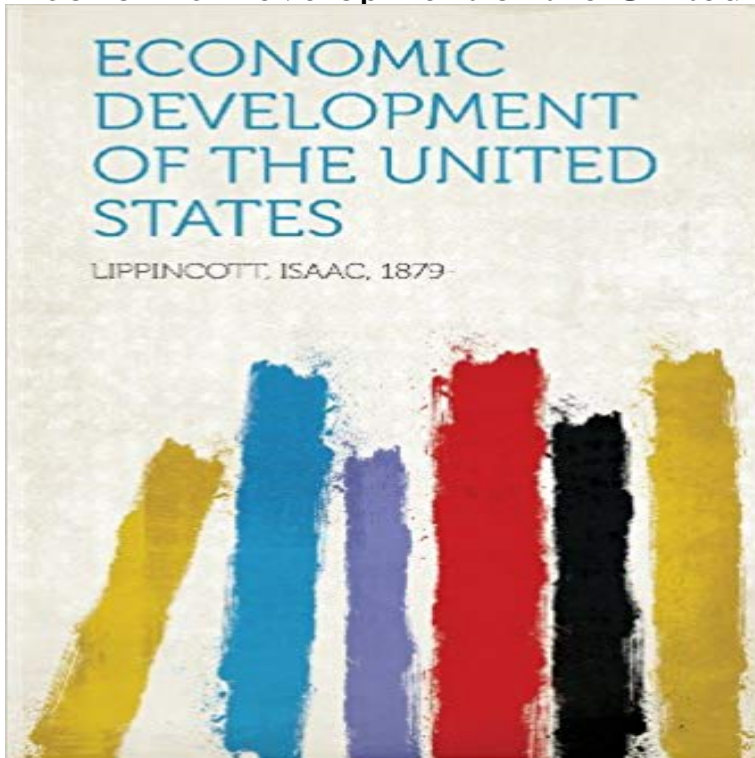


Economic Development of the United States
