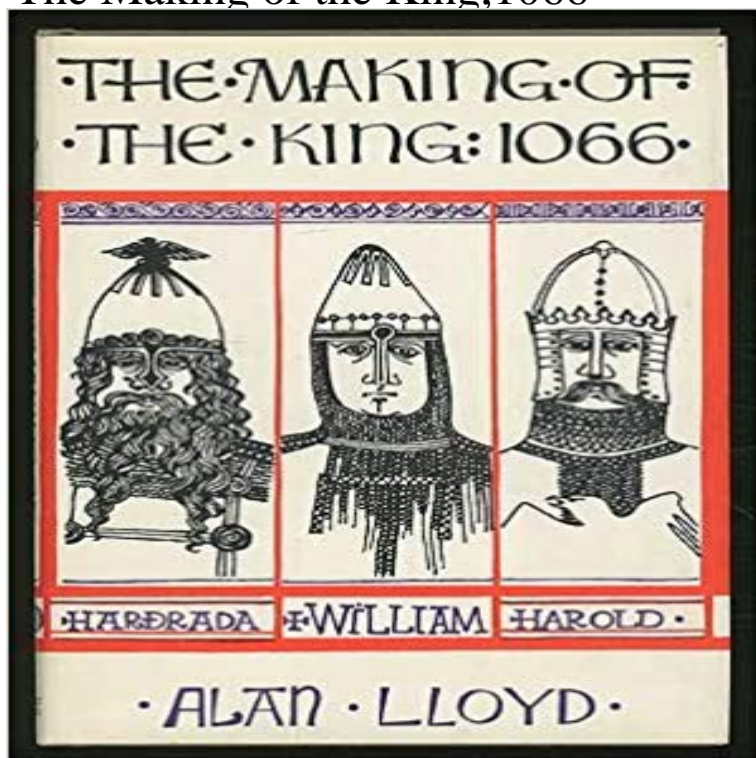


## The Making of the King,1066
